## Pruning and Replacement of Trees on 4th Street - Next Friday

A number of trees on 4th Street will be pruned next Friday, May 21. Vehicular and pedestrian traffic flow should not be significantly impacted.

Due to the current drought conditions, we are waiting to replace the dead trees until the fall/winter when they'll have a better chance of survival and less water will be needed to establish them. Both Crape Myrtles and Gingkoes will be planted throughout all three blocks. Please reach out to me with any questions.
